The Summit, which is being financed by the European Union and US Department of State, Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs, among others, will convene mayors and other local government leaders, as well as city-level practitioners and civil society actors from more than 70 cities around the globe. The multi-dimensional programme is designed **to showcase the unique contributions that mayors and local governments have made and can make in preventing and responding to rising levels of hate and extremist violence and the democratic backsliding that a growing number of communities are facing**. Throughout the Summit, emphasis will be placed on the importance of ensuring all city-led efforts in this area are non-discriminatory and, more broadly, promote human rights.

As outlined in the attached draft agenda, planned Summit activities include events with Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs, the Mayor of New York City's Office for the Prevention of Hate Crimes, the Global Counterterrorism Forum as well as a meeting of the Strong Cities Network's revitalized International Steering Committee, which the Mayor of New York City will host at Grace Mansion. In addition, mayors and other Summit attendees will have the opportunity to participate, where feasible, in other events being planned for the opening week of the 78th UNGA, including those related to the role of mayors and local governments in addressing hate, extremism, mis- and disinformation and other global challenges.
